HOLIDAY OVERVIEW

Bordered by Switzerland to the north and Italy to the east, Haute-Savoie is dominated by the high peaks of the French Alps and glistening lakes. Often referred to as the 'Pearl of the Alps' or 'Venice of the Alps', Annecy can trace its origins back to the time of the Romans. Situated in a commanding position at the head of Lake Annecy, the town offers a variety of quaint cafes, local history and culture. As you stroll through this ancient city, you will see the gorgeous Palais de L'Isle, a historical prison located in the centre of the Canal du Thiou which now houses a local history museum.



TRIP SUITABILITY

This is a level 2 and level 4 graded Activity, Easier walks: 5 to 8 miles (8 to 13km) on good paths. Up to 1,800 feet (540m) of ascent in a day. Harder walks: 7 to 11 miles (11 to 17½km) with some steep ascents and rough sections. Up to 3,600 feet (1,080m) of ascent in a day.



ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival Day

Welcome to Hotel Splendid. Unpack and settle in.

Day 2: Exploring Lake Annecy

Our transport will take us to the start of our walks on the western shore of Lake Annecy. Both groups will return to the hotel using the Lake Annecy passenger ferry.

Day 3: Glières Plateau

The Plateau des Glières was the site chosen as a command post by a Free French resistance group, who were eventually overrun by German forces in March 1944. There is a small museum and evocative memorial to the

men of the Maquis.

Day 4: The Bauges Mountains

Today takes us to the beautiful Massif des Bauges in neighbouring Savoie. With its traditional farms and barns, and unhurried way of life, it feels like stepping back in time.

Day 5: Free Day

Each week there is a free day when no guided walks are offered. This is an ideal opportunity to relax around Annecy, walk independently or visit local places of interest.

Day 6: Into The Heart Of The Aravis

Both groups will journey by coach to the start of these walks at Les Confins and finish at the Col des Annes. This area is dominated by the towering limestone peaks of the Aravis mountains.

Day 7: Eastern Shore

For our final walks of the week we visit the eastern shore of Lake Annecy. Our transport takes us to the Col de Bluffy to start – with the harder walk heading north and the easier walk south.

Day 8: Departure Day

We hope to see you again soon.

ACCOMMODATION

Hotel Splendid - Annecy

This 3-star hotel is conveniently located overlooking the Canal du Vasse and a short walk from the medieval centre of Annecy as well as the lake, which is access via a large and pleasant public park.

Rooms

There is a ground floor reception and the bedrooms are on the first, second and third floor with views to the Lake or overlooking the old town. The hotel has 47 ensuite rooms with telephone, TV, free room safe, hairdryer, complimentary toiletries, mini-bar, tea/coffee making facilities as well as a coffee machine.

The owner of the hotel has thoughtfully provided a small library of books in each room.

Our guests will be provided with 2 free bottles of water in their room.

Facilities

There is a cosy bar and a lounge area which opens out onto a balcony with seating to enjoy the view on warmer evenings. Next to this is the breakfast dining room. The guests also have use of a computer to access the internet and on the top floor there is a small gym, accessed via the room keycard.

Food & Drink

Our holidays at Hotel Splendid are on a Half Board basis and include breakfast and evening meal. Our groups will be dining at a local restaurant just a few minutes walk from the hotel where they will enjoy a 3-course served meal with options and all dietary requirements are catered for.

Travel Details

THE HASSLE-FREE OPTION

Book your holiday 'with flight' and choose between Heathrow or Manchester flights to Geneva airport.

If you choose this option we automatically include return transfers between the airport and the hotel. The coach transfer takes approx 1 hour 15 minutes to the Hotel Splendid.

THE FLEXIBLE TRAVEL OPTION

Alternatively, tailor your journey to suit you by booking your holiday 'without flight' allowing you the freedom to book your own flights from your local airport.

If you choose this option, transfers are not included in the price. However, we can book you a seat on the HF Holidays' transfer coach from Geneva airport. This is timed to meet the HF Holidays' flights* (provisional flight times can be found on the dates and prices tab or you can call us on 020 8732 1220 for more information). Cost per single journey is £37

USEFUL HOLIDAY INFORMATION

What To Bring

Essential Equipment

To enjoy walking/hiking comfortably and safely, footwear, clothing and equipment needs to be suitable for the conditions. Safety and comfort are our priorities, so our advice is to come prepared for all eventualities.

- Footwear with a good grip on the sole (e.g. Vibram sole) is the key to avoiding accidents.
- Walking/hiking boots providing ankle support and good grip are recommended (ideally worn in), and specialist walking socks to avoid blisters.
- Several layers of clothing, which can be added or removed, are better than a single layer (include spares).
- Fabrics (lightweight and fast drying) designed for the outdoors are recommended.
- Waterproof jacket and waterproof over trousers.
- Warm hat and gloves.
- Denim jeans and capes are not suitable on any walks.
- Rucksack with a waterproof liner.
- Thermos flask for hot drink.
- Water bottle (at least 2 litre).
- Spare high-energy food such as a chocolate bar.
- Small torch.

- First aid kit – your leader's first aid kit doesn't contain any medication or blister kits (such as Compeed).
- Sun hat and sunglasses
- Sun cream.

Optional Equipment

- Walking poles are useful, particularly for descents.
- Insect repellent.
- Camera.
- Gaiters.
