



## Assisted Holidays

A pathway of help for those in need

The Pathways Fund can provide a holiday in suitable cases where, because of difficult personal circumstances, the normal holiday price is beyond the means of those who would appreciate the social activities and open air life to be found at our Houses. The Assisted Holiday can cover up to the full price of the holiday and possibly a contribution to travel costs. In addition to the published booking conditions in the current and relevant brochure the following conditions apply:

- 1 Applications must be supported by a Member of the Society.
- 2 The holiday may not exceed one week, and can be taken at any time of year (subject to availability) at an HF Holidays owned House in the UK.
- 3 HF Holidays offer active, sociable holidays. Applicants will be expected to take part in the organised programme. Applicants must be willing and able to co-operate with other guests in the normal HF Holidays' activities without special attention or consideration. Applicants will be required to complete and return the HF Holidays Guest Holiday Survey form within two weeks of the end of the holiday.
- 4 Applicants will be treated in every way as ordinary guests. The information given on the application form and the special arrangement in regard of payments will be a matter of confidence and processed in accordance with HF Holidays data protection policy.
- 5 Anybody in need can be considered for an Assisted Holiday.
- 6 There can be no guarantee of a second Assisted Holiday.
- 7 A signed and completed application form showing the preferred number of nights and date(s) must be submitted. Holidays are granted at the discretion of HF Holidays Ltd.
