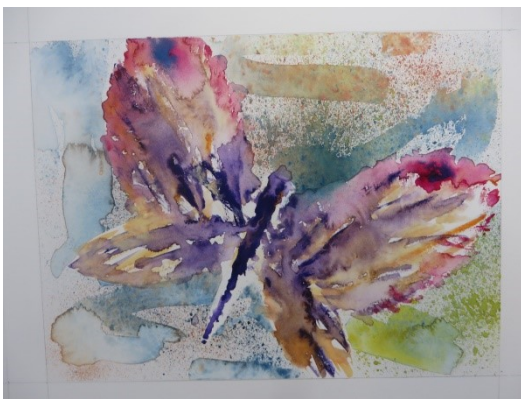


## How to paint a watercolour butterfly

### Steps to follow

- Fold an A4 sheet of paper in two
- Draw one side of the butterfly and cut it out with the paper still folded
- Open the cut-out to reveal the butterfly
- Place the outside 'template' on water colour paper and tack it into place using spray mount, blue tack or pins
- Paint the butterfly using water colour paints
- Remove the outside 'template and tack the inside 'template into place on the water colour paper, to cover the butterfly already painted
- Paint in the background

Subject matter includes landscape, seascape, the human form, animals and buildings. Mediums used are water colour, oil, acrylic and mixed media.
