Provide proof of your hotel booking on arrival – we recommend you print your HF Holidays confirmation before you depart.</li> </ol>	<p>Valid for at least 3 months from the date you return to the UK and less than 10 years old</p>

All passengers must complete a <a href="#">Passenger Locator Card</a></li> <li>2. Have appropriate valid proof of vaccination or recovery, <b>or</b> to present evidence of a negative PCR result from a test taken within 72 hours prior to arrival into the country if you are not fully vaccinated. You will also need to pay to take a test on arrival at the airport and self-isolate until you get the result. If you're staying longer than 7 days, you'll have to take either a PCR or Antigen test on day 8 of your stay and every 72 hours after.</li> </ol>	<p>Valid for at least 3 months from the date you return to the UK and less than 10 years old</p>

All passengers must complete an <a href="#">International Travel Form</a></li> <li>2. Have appropriate valid proof of vaccination or recovery, <b>or</b> to present evidence of a negative PCR result from a test taken within 72 hours prior to arrival into the country if you are not fully vaccinated.</li> <li>3. Complete the Airport Security Tax Form (TSA) on the <a href="#">EASE website</a> and pay 3,400 escudos (approximately £30).</li> </ol>	<p>Your passport should be valid for a minimum period of 6 months from the date of entry into Cape Verde</p>
<p>Morocco</p> <p>ONLY TRAVEL HERE IF YOU ARE FULLY VACCINATED</p> <p><a href="#">UK Government advice on travel to Morocco</a></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Complete a <a href="#">Traveller Registration</a></li> <li>2. Have appropriate valid proof of vaccination</li> <li>3. present evidence of a negative PCR result from a test taken within 48 hours prior to arrival into the country.</li> <li>4. On arrival, your temperature will be taken and you will need to take a free of charge antigen (rapid flow) test</li> </ol>	<p>Your passport should be valid for at least 3 months on your date of entry to Morocco</p>

Provide proof of full vaccination status</li></ol>	<p>Your passport should have at least one day's validity from the date you are leaving Costa Rica</p>

### Travelling back to the UK

If you are **fully vaccinated**

Before you travel to England you must:

- Take a COVID-19 test to be taken within the two days before you travel to England. This can be a PCR or lateral flow test. You cannot use an NHS test for this. You must use a private test provider. You can have the test sent to you at home before you go to take on holiday with you and complete the test towards the end of your holiday – via a video call or app. [Randox](#), for example, offer a remote lateral flow test to return pack which also includes your day 2 PCR test for £72. Alternatively, you could book and pay for the test in resort to be carried out at a supervised medical location, just speak to reception.
- Book and pay for a COVID-19 test – to be taken before the end of day 2 in England **You must take a PCR test**. You cannot use an NHS test for this. You must use a private test provider
- Complete a passenger locator form – to be completed in the 48 hours before you arrive in England. You will need to enter your COVID-19 test booking reference number on your passenger locator form.



## Entry Requirements & Covid-testing

*After you arrive in England you must:*

- Take a COVID-19 test on or before day 2. The day you arrive is day 0. This is the PCR test that you booked before travel. You must self-isolate in your home or the place you are staying until you receive your test result.

If you are ***not fully vaccinated***

*Before you travel to England you must:*

- Take a COVID-19 test to be taken within the two days before you travel to England. This can be a PCR or lateral flow test. You cannot use an NHS test for this. You must use a private test provider. You can have the test sent to you at home before you go to take on holiday with you and complete the test towards the end of your holiday – via a video call or app. [Randox](#), for example, offer a remote lateral flow test to return pack which also includes your day 2 PCR test for £72. Alternatively, you could book and pay for the test in resort to be carried out at a supervised medical location, just speak to reception.
- Book and pay for day 2 and day 8 COVID-19 PCR tests – to be taken after arrival in England
- Complete a passenger locator form – to be completed in the 48 hours before you arrive in England

*After you arrive in England you must:*

- Quarantine at home or in the place you are staying for 10 full days
- Take your COVID-19 PCR tests – you must book these tests before you travel. You must take the first test on or before day 2 and the second test on or after day 8. The day you arrive is day 0.



## Entry Requirements & Covid-testing

Please note, most big UK airports have testing providers on site who can carry out your PCR test as soon as you land. Alternatively, you can book an at home test that you post off to a lab and you'll usually get your result in around 48 hours.
